

Little League Majors Baseball (5th and 6th Grade)

Format:

This game program is designed to advance the instructional basics. This program also provides competitive games as a teaching tool for players. This program is for 5th and 6th grade players.

Sessions will include:

- 1 game during the week/1 game on Saturdays
- Time will be used to develop the basic fundamentals of play in game formats.
- Games will also be played under Little League rules with standings and a structured playoff format at the end of the season ending on Championship Saturday.

Schedule:

The schedule will include game time on Monday thru Thursdays at 6:00pm and games on Saturdays at either 9:00am or 11:30am over a scheduled 7 weeks.

The program is held from mid-April through mid-June (no sessions on Memorial Day weekend).

Registration:

Please register early to reserve your spot!

To register, go to **Community Pass** and select "**Ridgewood Baseball and Softball Association**" then "**2024 - Spring Recreational Season**". After you select your child and their current grade you will then see the "LL Majors Baseball (5th and 6th Grade)" option.

Coaching:

This league requires more than 100 volunteer coaches to run successfully. When registering your child in Community Pass please consider signing up as a "Coach" or "Assistant Coach".

Teams:

- There will be 8 teams. Teams will be created through a draft format of registered 6th graders and 5th graders. Registered 5th graders not drafted will be placed into the LL Minors draft pool.

Equipment/Uniforms:

Each player should wear molded cleats and gloves and helmets are required. Bats are recommended and should have the USA Baseball stamp. Player athletic cups for protection are recommended as well.

All players will receive a hat and a sponsored team jersey that must be worn to all events.
